Minutes

1. ESRI awards

Our submission has been sent for the "collaboration" award.

We do not have permission to use Durham mapping data for presentation. Anne-Louise suggested we could map some key features ourselves, so we are able to publish these without need for further permissions.

2. CIO update

The Charity Commission has responded to our revised application. They were more positive about this version, but still had concerns. Their suggestion is that we stop now and re-apply once the Neighbourhood Plan is finalised and agreed. We will do this.

3. NP draft update

Niamh has made mapping updates.

4. Catch up on GIS data input for GS and Heritage suggested approach from Jo- Anne Peter has done Benfieldside heritage. Anne-Louise has done Delves green spaces, but not heritage. Niamh to transfer her licence to John so he can do his updates (he will cover Delves heritage). We need Ian to summarise where we are now for other areas.

There will probably be a "mop up" session to finalise anything still missing.

As we complete them, we can pass the sites to Jo-Anne ward by ward (which she would prefer) so she can do her checks against planning submissions, etc.

5. Landowner Notification Process

Jo-Anne has provided a draft template for the notification letter/email. In terms of when to notify landowners, she recommends we wait until we have a better idea of which sites we want to protect as either Local Green Space or Protected Open Space – and let Jo-Anne look at them first.

So, she would suggest this process

- 1. Send list of sites and completed draft assessment forms to Jo-Anne to review she can advise whether specific sites should be LGS or POS (LGS gives the greatest level of protection).
- 2. Jo-Anne can then pull together a draft background paper which includes the methodology and the initial outcome of the assessments.
- 3. At that point, we notify the landowners
- 4. Do a community (and landowner) consultation on the draft background paper
- 5. Revise the background paper (and proposed allocations) following feedback.

The revised draft allocations are then included within the draft Neighbourhood Plan.
